Bids received after the specified time or received in any location other than that listed will not be accepted. No BIDDER may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the date of Bid opening.

Project includes approximately **Replacement and Rehabilitation of Lift Station 13** with all related accessories as shown on the plans and called for in the Contract Documents and Technical Specifications. Bids shall be on Unit Price Items. The project shall be Substantially Complete within **270 calendar** days from the date of notice to proceed of the contract.
